This 7 inch arcaded plate shows the popular Bamboo and Flowers pattern introduced c. 1820. The pattern is almost always found with the Semi China printed mark that is probably the earliest printed mark used by Minton. The pattern was found on a wide range of wares including jugs, bowls, dinner, tea and dessert wares. Many examples are illustrated on pages 153-55 in the reference cited. 2
